- 6615 **DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST**. Cllr. Lusty declared an interest in planning application 17/00708/AS and would leave the room when discussed.
- 6616 **MINUTES**. The minutes and report of the meeting held on 22<sup>nd</sup> May 2017 were confirmed and signed as correct records.

# 16/01529/AS Land to the rear of 3-7 High Street.

(**DEL**) Erection of covered market stalls over existing open paved area. **NOTED**.

#### 17/00456/AS Woolpack Hotel, 26 High Street.

Repainting of brickwork and woodwork on front and part side elevations of the building.

SUPPORT but recommend that the Borough Planners liaise with the applicant on the colour.

## 17/00683/AS Great Bulleign, Smallhythe Road.

Erection of 3 bay cart lodge garage with office and storage above.

### 17/00708/AS Land North of 14 Westwell Court.

Erection of a fifty-six bed care home and 23 units for assisted living (use class C2) comprising 16 cottages and seven flats (including Manager's accommodation) with associated landscaping, parking, stores and service areas, estate roads, access and landscaping buffers.

The Committee heard presentations from Cllr. Sugden of Rogersmead (not a member of this Committee), Mr. R. Masefield of West Cross Gardens, Mr. T. Escott of Westwell Court, Ms. J. Kingston of Westwell Court who all objected to the application. Objections included lack of documentation with the planning application, the siting of the nursing home, the proximity to a badger sett, width of access and lack of alternative emergency access. S. Davies of Hobbs & Parker presented on behalf of the developer, stating that the project was a well-considered and high quality scheme.

DEFERRED. The Committee agreed that a site visit needed to take place and a representative from the developers and a Borough Councillor would need to be present. The application will be discussed at the next Planning meeting.
