Finance & General Purposes; 5th September 2016.

Committee recommendations:

<u>Minute 3553 (d)- Standing Orders, Financial Regulations & Donations</u>. To amend the complaints procedure to include an addition to paragraph 2d (employee conduct) as follows: "Where the complainant is a Councillor, the complaint must be made in writing on the official pro-forma to clearly identify it as a formal complaint in order to invoke this procedure", and to remove the redundant Standing Order 14b (relating to complaints against Councillors).

<u>Minute 3555 - Armed Forces Covenant</u>. To sign the Armed Forces Covenant, pledging fair treatment for past and present members of the armed forces and their families.

<u>Minute 3557 - Refreshments for Council-Organised Events</u>. To allocate a budget of £50.00 per event for refreshments at events organised by the Town Council. If this amount was insufficient for an event, the issue would be assessed on a case-by-case basis.

<u>Minute 3558 - Staffing Matters</u>. To employ a part-time member of staff to man the Tourist Information Centre at weekends.

<u>Minute 3068 - St. Michaels Recreation Ground Access</u>. To accept a quote of £24,421.00 from Initial Systems Ltd. for works to create the access to St. Michaels Recreation Ground.

<u>Minute 3069 - Caretaker Scheme</u>. ABC had reported that the inclusion of Cranbrook Road cemetery in the maintenance contract was not negotiable, but had increased its offer to £34,854.00 per annum. A break clause after three years would be included in the contract. It was therefore recommended that the contract should be taken on. It would be required that the cemetery would be handed over in a good state of maintenance at the outset of the contract.
