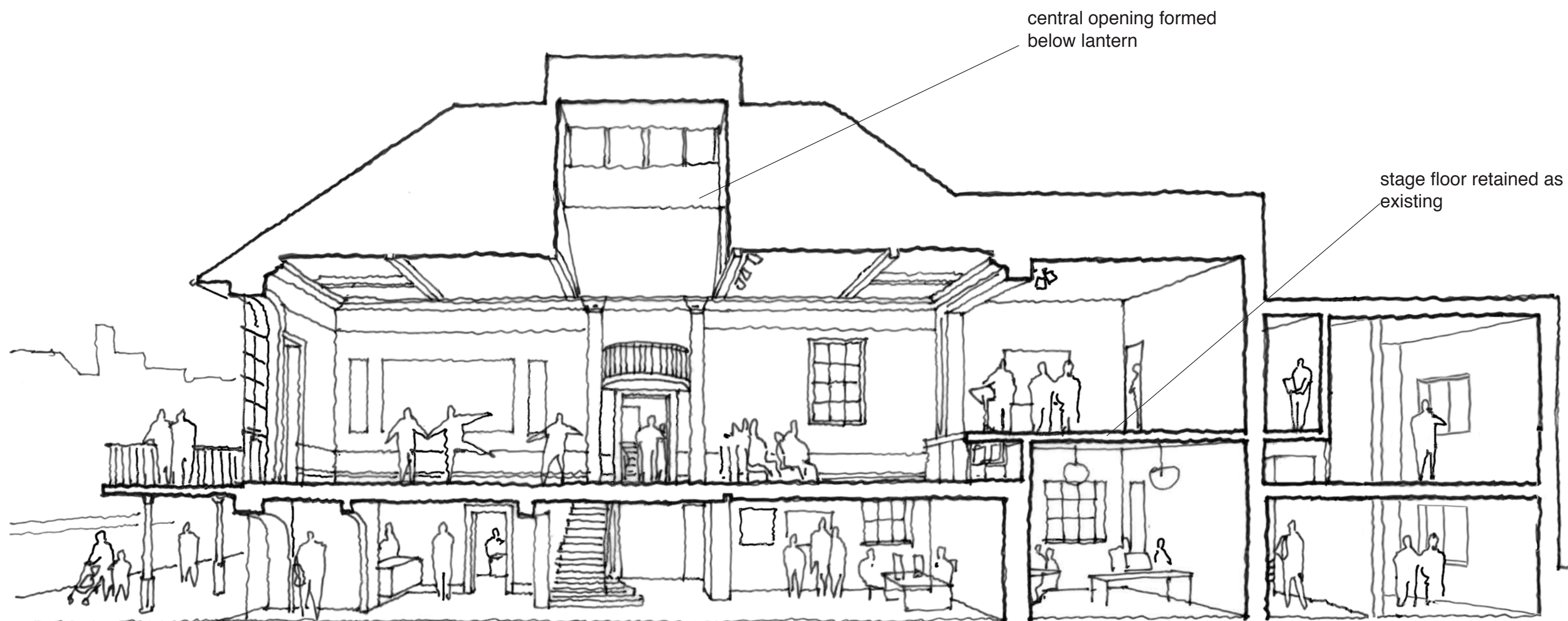

Proposed Scheme Section

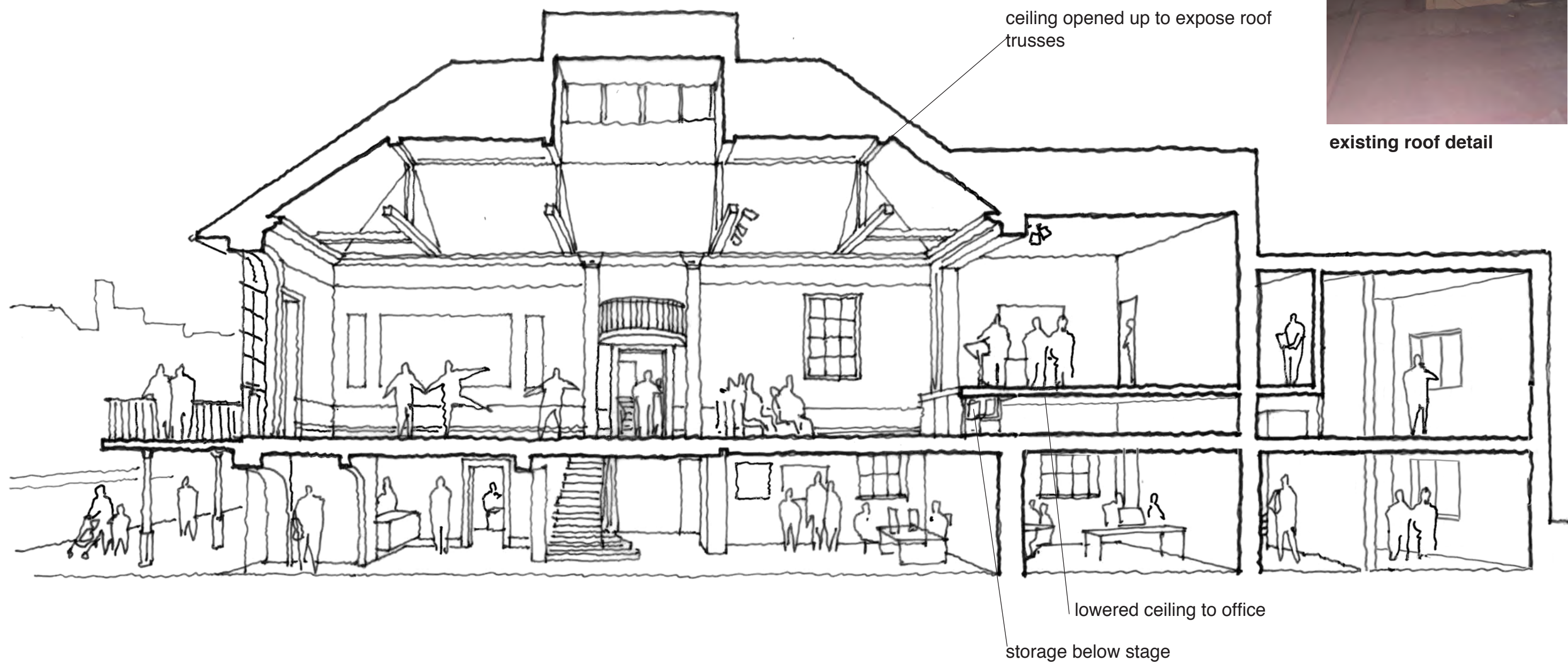

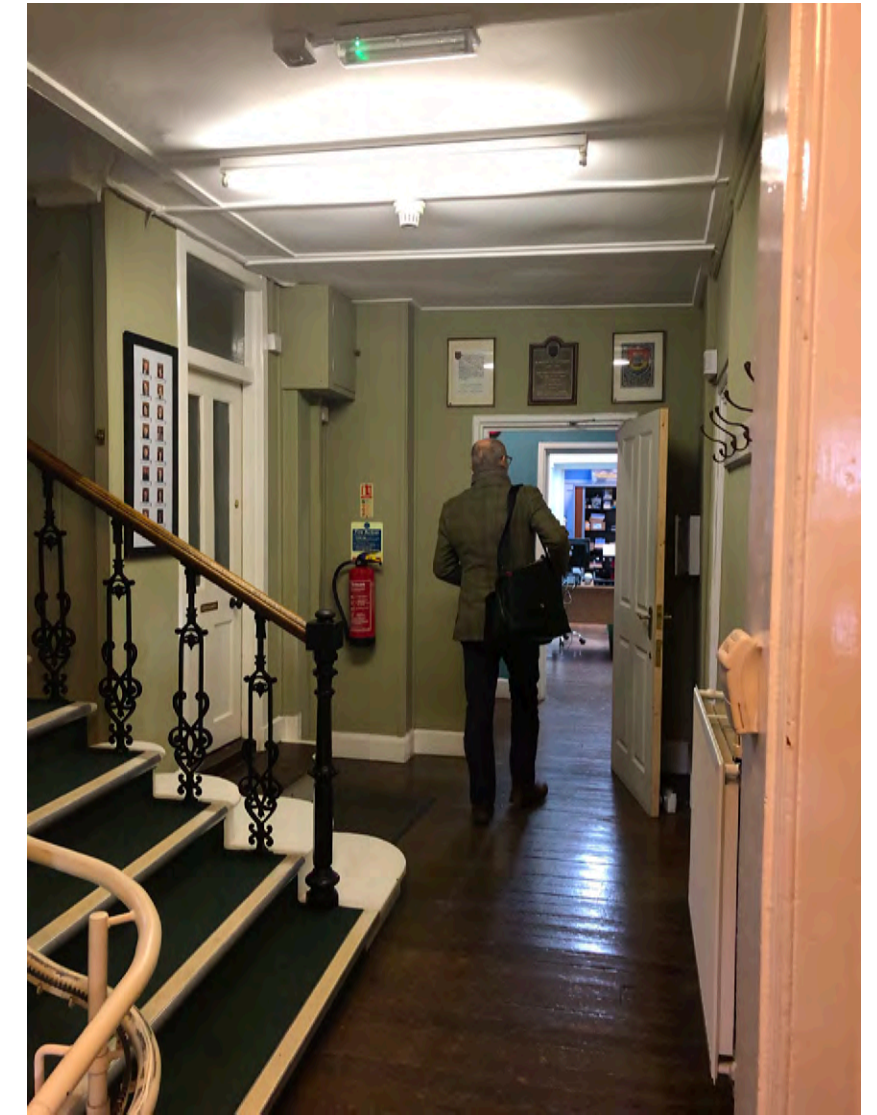

First Floor Landing



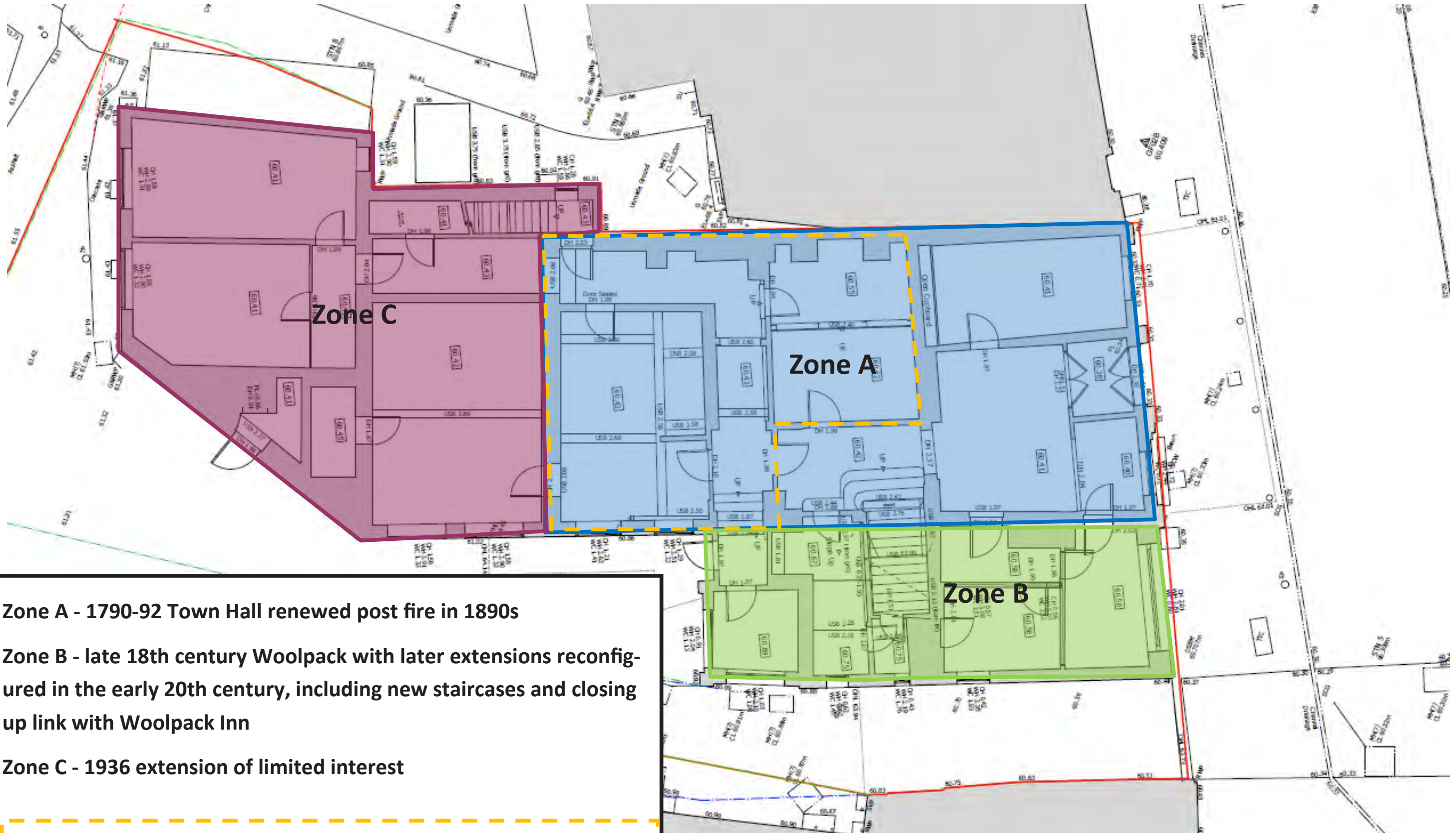

Zone B - late 18th century Woolpack with later extensions reconfigured in the early 20th century, including new staircases and closing up link with Woolpack Inn

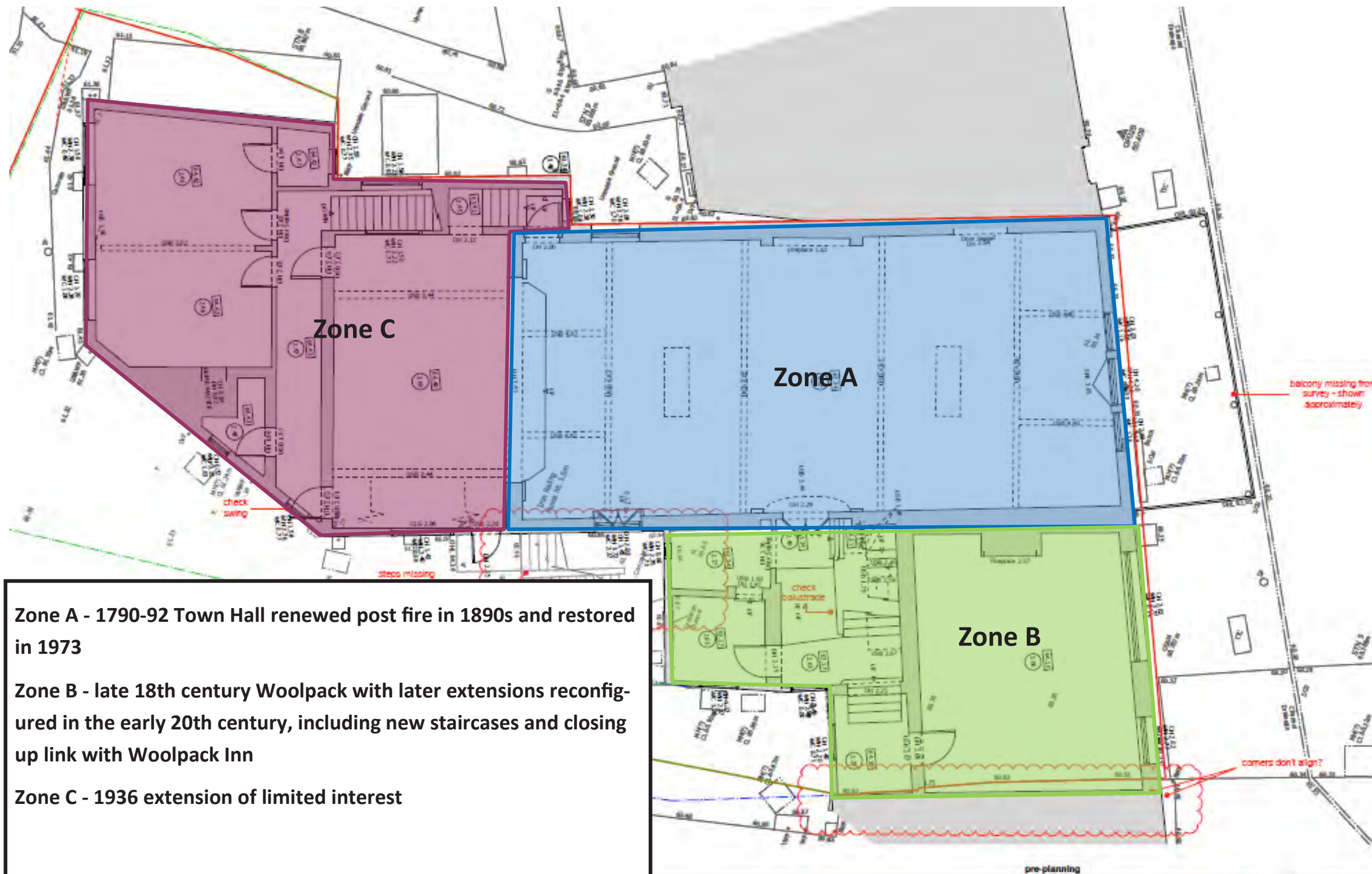
Zone C - 1936 extension of limited interest

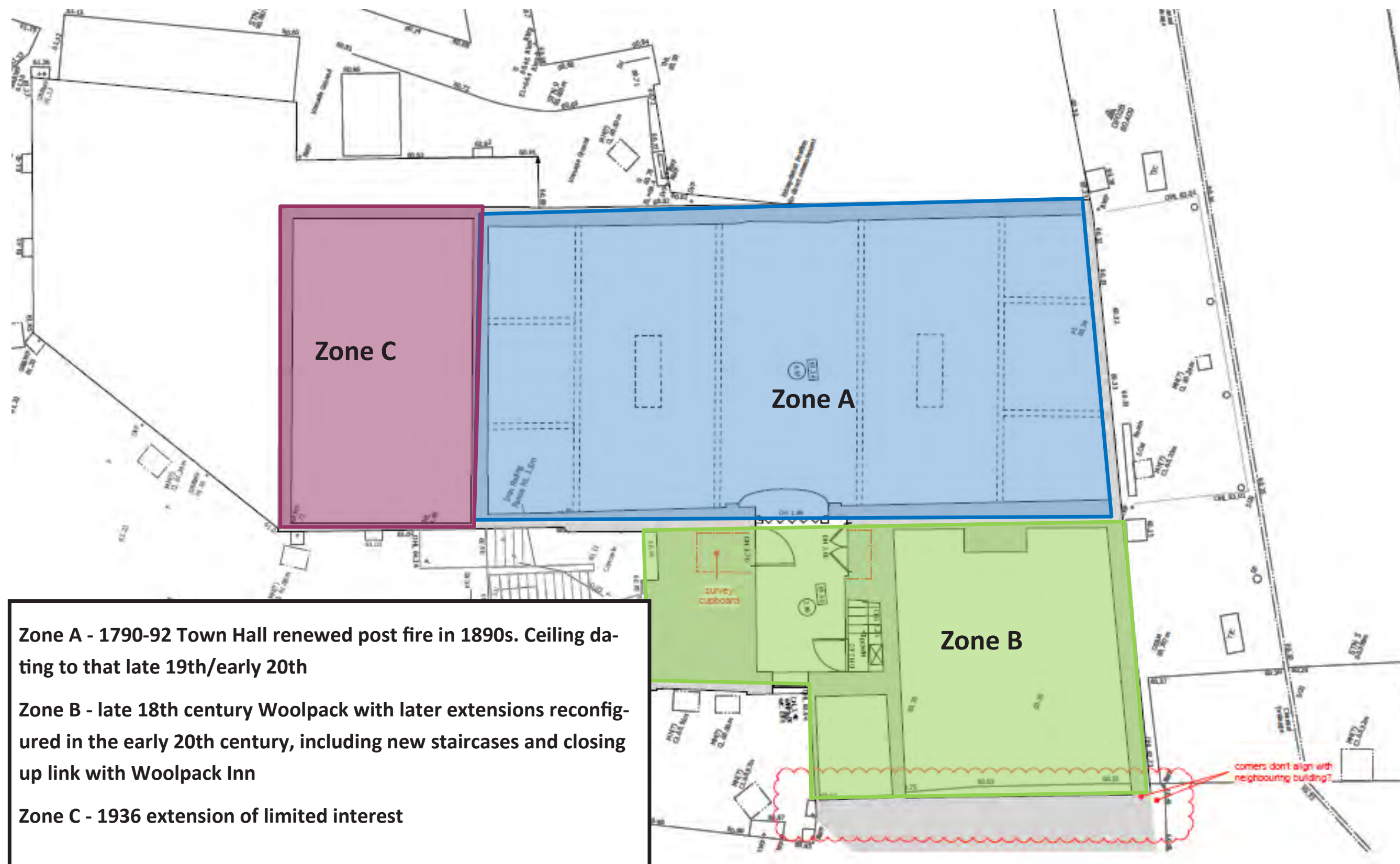
