Following an enquiry regarding the state of repairs at this location, a KCC Drainage engineer reported that they had had a quote for £22,000 for repairs in 2016. The project was revisited this year with more gullies damaged and the bill had risen to £47,000. As this amount was not in the KCC budget, the surface was made safe and will be regularly inspected. He accepts that it looks awful. This will be reviewed at the end of the year and if surplus budget exists they will replace.
