COMMUNITY GRANT APPLICATION ELIGILIBITY CRITERIA

Eligible projects should have the following features.

- 1. Legally permissible and within the Council's powers to fund (these powers are now extended under the General Power of Competence*).
- 2. A benefit for the community in the parish.
- 3. An element of permanence to the project.
- 4. Capital costs only would be allowed. No Revenue grants (running costs or day-to-day expenses) will normally be given.
- 5. Seed funding (including for businesses) would be considered in the event of a demonstrable benefit to the community.
- 6. The organisation must be local.
- 7. No national charities would be considered.

Further Guidance

- 1. Projects which would generate an income for the Council would be welcome.
- 2. Preference would be given to those projects attracting additional outside funding and those demonstrating a broader benefit to the community.
- 3. Feedback would be expected from funded projects to enable evaluation.
- 4. Evidence of grant applications to other bodies would be preferred. If none have been made, reasons should be provided.

*This power allows the council to act as an individual would do, that is anything which is not forbidden by law.
