

# Public Buildings Committee – 17<sup>th</sup> October 2016 Pilates & Yoga Classes Agenda Item 7

An extract from an e-mail request for exemption of charges is attached below. A presentation will be made by the Genevieve Pollock who wishes to run Pilates and Yoga classes from the Town Hall for survivors of breast cancer.

Issues for the council to consider are as follows:

- Classes would ideally be in the morning to avoid ad-hoc afternoon bookings and a charge for security (which is levied outside office hours)
- Not-for-profit organisations have in the past been charged at a concessionary rate of £15 per hour
- · We currently have no regular events which are excused payment.

Council may well consider that this is warranted in the circumstances however.

## Recreation Ground Kiosk

Work is due to be complete by Easter 2017. An outline application has been submitted for LEADER funding, and a response is awaited.

#### Sink Hole Between the Woolpack Hotel and the Town Hall.

The offer from Enterprise Inns of payment for "capping" the sink hole in return for exemption from any further expenditure on the access way was rejected by this committee. I have advised Enterprise that the 50/50 offer is still open with exemption from further expense on this issue. When I spoke to the representative of Enterprise, he said he would forward a precontract document for us to consider. This may still be unacceptable but we will know for sure when this arrives.
