10.35 am Parade from Recreation Ground to War Memorial

10.45 am Service at War Memorial

11.00 am Two minutes silence then laying of wreaths

11.30 am Service ends and parade to Station Road Coach Park for dismissal.

11.45 am Everyone makes their way to the Railway for refreshments

12.30 pm Reverend John Emmott to conduct a requiem in front of the Cavell Van followed by laying of wreaths

12.50 pm Service ends and public are welcome to purchase soup and a roll from the Railway

1.15 pm A special train service will depart from Tenterden Station.

6.15 pm Public invited to arrive at the Recreation Ground in preparation for the lighting of the Beacon

6.40 pm Short service conducted by Canon Lindsay Hammond and blessing of the Beacon

6.55 pm Lighting of the Beacon by Freeman of the Town and founder of the Tenterden Lions, Roger Champion, who will be assisted by the Mayor of Tenterden, Dr Raymond Crawford (Freeman of the Town) and Mike Caridia (President of the Tenterden Lions Club).
