Hello all, I have been out across my wards listening to residents' concerns and answering their questions. Issues of parking problems have been highlighted and I have liaised with the relevant agency and updated with the locations. Recently, I along with the Neighbourhood Task Force PCSOs have conducted high visibility patrols in Tenterden following reports of a male approaching females and asking personal questions which has caused concerns. In relation to this we conducted research on our call system and found that there were calls of a similar nature in other areas with the same description given of the male. We identified the male and police intervention has been made. In the past week there was an incident of Affray in High Halden area where two persons were fighting in a residential street. A suspect left the scene in an unknown vehicle. I assisted the Local Policing Team in attending the call. With limited information regarding the vehicle, we dug deeper and were able to identify it. As a result, the offender was located and arrested the same evening.
