Introduction

The outbreak of Codiv19 has precluded asking each group to edit their entry and, therefore, if you see something that is not right, please inform me so that I may ensure that it is updated in the next edition of the Directory. I am particularly keen to capture any changes to the long-term arrangements for LIG meetings as well as changes in the details of contacts and how to communicate with them.
